

DEFINITIONS OF THE SERVICE OF GENERAL INTEREST

A service of general interest is a service created, organised or regulated by a public authority to ensure that the service is supplied in the manner which it considers necessary to satisfy society's needs.

Among services of general interest, services of general economic interest are services which are

BASE OF THE WELFARE SOCIETY


CURRENT SITUATION AND DEVELOPMENT TENDENCIES OF THE SERVICES OF GENERAL INTEREST


GENERAL INTEREST AND COMPETITION

Public authorities have the responsibility for:


- seeking the optimal balance among achieving the best short term and long term cost/effectiveness ratio, the tasks of the general interest services in consideration and other services which might be affected, and
